Did you know that you can fill out a short, simple application (which we'll help you with and drop in the mail!) to help keep Peace Place here for your family and others who follow you?

The **Montana Lifespan Respite Voucher** has a large grant available to YOUR family and best of all, it's a simple process.

Once the form comes in and is approved, money is available for any respite you use. Say you receive \$300 for 2016. Any amount of that \$300 may be donated for Peace Place services (for families with higher incomes, there may be a co-pay). We fill out a voucher, send it back to Montana Lifespan Respite, and you receive a FULL REIMBURSEMENT for each dollar you spent!


PARENTS AS TEACHERS PRESENTS
